The proposed Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) forces all areas in England to make huge cuts to services to balance the books. Sustainability and Transformation Plan? We know that STP really spells out "Slash, Trash and Privatise".

Here in the North East, last year we witnessed the "temporary" closure of the in-patient ward at Rothbury Community Hospital, reduced hours at Hexham, Wansbeck and North Tyneside Urgent Care Centres, the planned reduction of walk-in centres in North Tyneside from three to one in October 2017, proposals to downgrade South Tyneside Hospital, with the immediate threat being the loss of stroke and emergency services from South Tyneside to Sunderland, and the proposed closure of either Darlington Memorial or North Tees A&E. This is but the start. Further cuts and closures are planned, and health managers now need to consult on these proposals.
